



2013 Rosé of Pinot Noir Bucher Vineyard – Russian River Valley Sonoma County

Vineyard: Located in the heart of the Russian River Valley, Bucher Vineyard was founded in 1997 by John Bucher for Bucher Farms. After graduating from UC Davis, John returned to Healdsburg to manage the family dairy farm and soon diversified into wine grapes. Additional plantings followed in 1998, 1999, 2006, 2008, and 2009. The 35 acres of land, with 14 blocks of wine grapes, are owned by John and his parents, and farmed by John for Bucher Farms. The Pinot Noir blocks are comprised of several clones, as well as various rootstock.

Vintage Notes: Our first Rosé of Pinot Noir comes from one ton of fruit harvested from the Pear Tree block. We selected this block for the delicious aromas and flavors produced by the 667 clone fruit planted here. We were not disappointed with the results.

Tasting Notes: Beautiful hues of coral draw you to delectable aromas of orange blossom, wild strawberries, and pomegranate. Bright flavors of cranberry, juicy strawberry, and blood orange zest spring forward to a crisp and balanced finish.
