



2014 Chardonnay Unoaked Russian River Valley – Sonoma County

Our Vineyard: Located in the heart of the Russian River Valley, Bucher Vineyard was founded in 1997 by John Bucher for Bucher Farms. After graduating from UC Davis, John returned to Healdsburg to manage the family dairy farm and soon diversified into wine grapes. Additional plantings followed in 1998, 1999, 2006, 2008, and 2009. The 35 acres of land, with 14 blocks of wine grapes, are owned by John and his parents, and farmed by John for Bucher Farms. The Pinot Noir blocks are comprised of several clones, as well as various rootstock.

Vintage Notes: Our 2014 Russian River Chardonnay comes from an ideal growing season. The moderately warm growing season, coupled with a dramatic cooling trend right before harvest, allowed for extraordinary hang time. This allowed the fruit to develop rich flavors and complex aromas.

Tasting Notes: Lush apples, sweet mandarin zest and tropical fruit are introduced on the aromas of this beautiful wine. Flavors of juicy pear, apples, pineapple blend into layers of palate complexity. Succulent tropical fruit flavors bring home a lengthy finish.
